GENERAL GUIDELINES		Manuscripts should be COMPLETE, CONCISE and CLEAR (See EASE Guidelines , available in many languages). Follow the appropriate reporting guidelines where applicable.
WORD LIMITS, etc.		
Body Text		InterPore Journal currently does not have any limits set for any of the article types. Instead, we will currently leave this up to the Reviewers and Editor to comment upon should they feel that the text is overly long or wordy.
Abstract		The abstract should be no longer than 1 page of text. A graphical abstract may also be included with the text if this helps in conveying the message of your work. An abstract is not required for the following types of articles: Commentaries on Previously Published Articles, Letters to the Editor, and Opinion Pieces.
Keywords		At least three and ideally, no more than five keywords should be provided. A keyword can also be a phrase composed of multiple words.
Highlights / Key Message		We currently do not require this; it is the authors decision to include this as a text box in their paper if they would like to.
Tables / Figures		There is currently no limit on the number of tables and/or figures one should include. This will be left up to the Reviewers and assigned Editor to comment upon if they feel it is too many. Color should however be used when possible.

Title		The Title should be a clear and concise and be an accurate representation of the content of your work.

Short Running Title	None needed as this will be done by the Editorial Office during the production stage if your paper is accepted.
Author Names	<p>All names of those who can be considered an author according to the ICMJE guidelines should be listed. The full first names, initials, and surnames should be included. Do not use only initials with the surnames.</p> <p>Deceased persons who meet the criteria for authorship should be listed along with a note regarding date of death. A collaboration group can be listed as an author; all members of the collaboration group should be included in the acknowledgements section.</p>
Affiliation Information Required	The institution listed for each author should represent the institution where they were when the work was performed. If any author has since moved to a new institution, the new institution can be included along with a note that this is their current institution.
Corresponding Author Contact Details	At least one author needs to be indicated as a contact and the contact information given should be not likely to change anytime soon, and include the institutional address, telephone number and an email address.
Persistent Identifiers of Author(s), etc.	ORCID ID's, as well as any other persistent identifier, should be included for every author that possesses one.

Typical Headings and Subheadings	<p>The main text should contain the body of the article and can be broken down into (sub)sections with short and informative headings.</p> <p>The following typical sessions should be included, when relevant: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion and/or Summary & Conclusions. The last section should include, when relevant, questions which could be addressed in future research and investigation.</p>
Materials and Methods	<p>Please make as detailed as necessary so that others can easily and successfully reproduce or build upon your work. Depending on length, a short version with the main details can be included in the main text of the paper, and a full version with all details can be included as supplementary material.</p> <p>The following information can be included in this section:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complex procedural details • Step by step protocols • Listing of all materials and equipment used • Listing of all software packages used & key settings

Proposed Reviewers / Reviewers to Avoid	<p>During the submission process there will be the following two fields which can be filled in: Preferred Reviewers & Reviewers to Avoid.</p> <p>The names provided should have no association with the author(s), and they cannot be former supervisors, current or past close collaborators, or from the same institution.</p>

Figures	<p>When possible, please insert all figures into the text in their appropriate location.</p> <p>The original figure files should also be saved as these will be needed for the production process if your paper is accepted. The following formats are possible: jpg, tiff, gif, png, or eps</p> <p>Resolution should be at minimum 150 DPI.</p>
Supplementary Files	<p>Upload as separate documents.</p> <p>These can include further tables, figures, diagrams, videos, etc.</p>
Fees and Payments	<p>There is an article processing charge (APC) for all accepted papers. For Original Research and Review Papers: €700 for Institutional members, €1000 for the rest. For Short Communications and Technical Notes, €500 for Institutional Members, €750 for the rest. APC Waivers are possible for authors from low or lower-middle income countries. For further information.</p> <p><i>**There will be no APC during the first year of publishing.</i></p>
